

Terms & Conditions: Win a Hot Lap with Fair Dinkum Sheds Racing and a Weekend at the V8s Promotion

Acceptance by you

The "Win a Hot Lap with Fair Dinkum Sheds Racing and a Weekend at the V8s" Promotion ("the competition") is provided by FBHS (Aust) Pty Limited ABN 83 126 232 504 (within Australia) and Delcon Holdings (No.11) Limited (Company number 1855412) (within New Zealand) both trading as Fair Dinkum Homes & Sheds ("the promoter") contactable at PO Box 252, Camden 2570 NSW. These terms and conditions (including without limitation the information on how to enter and prize details which we publish in relation to the competition) apply to the competition. By entering the competition, you acknowledge that you have read and understood, and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS YOU MUST NOT ENTER THE COMPETITION.

Entering the competition

1. To be eligible to enter the competition, you must be a permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand. Our employees, our associated agencies' employees, our Authorised Distributors and their employees and members of their immediate families are ineligible to enter the competition.
2. Entry is open to all persons aged 18 years or over who order a Steel Building or Carport from an Authorised Distributor of the Promoter during the Promotional Period (as defined below). Ordering a Steel Building or Carport is defined as the Promoter's Authorised Distributor placing the order through the Promoter's ordering system
3. All orders placed during the Promotional Period will be automatically entered into the draw. If an order is subsequently cancelled it will be removed from the draw. An order does not have to be completed and fully paid within the Promotional Period to be eligible.

The competition runs from 1/04/2010 at 12:01am to 31/05/2010 at 11.59pm ("Promotional Period"). All times are AEST or AEDST, whichever is applicable in NSW. Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter.

4. Multiple entries are permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one entry will be recorded per order (regardless of the amount spent or the number of participating products purchased in the same transaction); and (b) each order must be in accordance with entry requirements.
5. Prize:

There is only 1 prize for this competition and this includes the following:

- Flights to Melbourne Australia (only one of the following two flight packages will be awarded as the prize) –
 - From the winner's nearest capital city in any State or Territory in Australia except Melbourne (if the winner purchases a Fair Dinkum Homes & Sheds Product within Australia),
 - 2 Return Economy Class Tickets to Melbourne (If the winner's nearest capital city is Melbourne, no flights will be included and the winner will not be entitled to the cash equivalent or any other benefit in substitution for the flights) – To the maximum value of \$1,000 including taxes; or

Brad Jones Racing reserves the right to refuse the participant the "Hot Lap Experience" If –

- the team believes the participant to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol
 - the team, in its wisdom and expertise, believe the hotlap participant to be a danger to themselves, the driver, the team or the V8 Supercar by participating in a V8 hotlap
 - the participant refuses to sign the disclaimer
- 2 x 3 day paddock passes to the Phillip Island V8 supercar event on 10-12 September 2010 – Valued at \$100 each. Total \$200; and
 - 1 amount of Spending Money – Value AUD\$800.
6. All Values Quoted in Australian Dollars and include GST. All Prizes Relate to the Phillip Island V8 supercar event on 10th - 12th September 2010
 7. Once booked, any changes made to the booking will incur a cancellation fee or amendment fee, at the cost of the winner. Travel will be arranged by the Promoter.
 8. Accommodation and flights are subject to airline and hotel availability.
 9. Prize must be taken in its entirety. All components of the prize must be taken together. Travel insurance is not included. Travel prize does not include meals or transport to and from departure and arrival points. All other ancillary and travel costs are the winner's responsibility. If the prize winner wishes to make variations to the travel component of the prize, any costs incurred in varying the flights offered as part of the competition prize are the winner's responsibility and must be booked separately by the winner.

 17. The Promoter's decision is final and binding - no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute.

Limitation of liability

18. The Promoter is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by you or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in the competition, or by any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of the competition including any

omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.

19. The Promoter is not responsible for any tax implications that may arise from prize winnings in the competition. You should seek Independent financial advice about such matters.
20. The Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including without limitation direct, indirect and consequential loss and damages) or for personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of entering or trying to enter the competition or accepting the prize offered as part of the competition, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law
21. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss suffered to any person or property by reason of any act or omission, whether deliberate or negligent, by the Promoter or its employees or agents or its Authorised Distributors or their employees or agents, in connection with the arrangement for the supply of goods and services by any person to the prize winner and, where applicable, to any persons accompanying the prize winner. This clause does not affect any rights a consumer may have which are unable to be excluded under Australian or New Zealand law. To the fullest extent permitted by the respective laws of Australia and New Zealand (as applicable), any liability of the Promoter or its employees or agents for any such loss is limited to the payment of the costs of having the prize supplied again.

In the event of war, terrorism, state of emergency, disaster or (without limitation) any other event outside our reasonable control, we are entitled to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition - subject to any written directions from the various regulatory bodies responsible for supervising the conduct of the competition in Australia & New Zealand.
23. If for any reason the competition is not capable of running as planned (including but not limited to) technical failures, unauthorised intervention, fraud or any other causes beyond our control which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, we are entitled in our sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
24. The law implies various conditions and warranties which might apply to us supplying goods or services to you. We exclude all of those conditions and warranties to the fullest extent permitted by law, including without limitation implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

Virus Warning

25. In entering the competition, you assume the risks and responsibility for any loss, damage or consequence resulting directly or indirectly from viruses, damage or other defects.

Termination

26. We may terminate or cancel your entry in the competition immediately in our reasonable discretion or if you breach any of your obligations under these conditions subject to consultation with the relevant legislative authorities before any action is taken.

Your personal information

27. No personal information of an entrant will be collected by the Promoter other than which is obtained by the Authorised Distributor when an entrant places an order. The winner of the prize will be required to provide certain personal information. If you do not give us the information, you cannot claim the prize. The details provided are protected by security safeguards as detailed in the Promoter's Privacy Policy, a copy of which is available on request.

You indemnify us

28. You agree to keep us indemnified from any claim, cost, demand, tax, liability or damage (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis) suffered or incurred by us, our directors, employees, agents, representatives or any third party arising out of your participation in the competition and acceptance of the prize.

Failure to comply and severability

29. We are not liable for any failure to comply with these conditions. If any part or provision in these conditions is found to be invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason, that part or provision shall be severed and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force.

Entire agreement and governing law

30. These conditions constitute the entire agreement between you and us as to its subject matter. By entering the competition, you accept that this agreement is to be interpreted, and any disputes are to be determined, by the courts having jurisdiction in New South Wales (if you purchased your Fair Dinkum Homes and Sheds Product in Australia) or New Zealand (if you purchased your Fair Dinkum Homes and Sheds Product in New Zealand), in accordance with the laws in force in the relevant jurisdiction from time to time.
